Document requesting loan repayments

This letter should be drawn up by the settlor and sent to the trustees, when setting up a Loan Trust, to formalise the repayment schedule of the loan to the settlor in circumstances where it is intended to start taking repayment in the near future. Your financial adviser may wish to adapt this wording, or draw up their own wording, in conjunction with a lawyer.
